

Pet Emergency Kit Checklist

Our pets completely depend on us for their care and safety. It's important to prepare them along with your families. Create or update your pet emergency kit today, to reduce stress in evacuations.



Food. At least a 3 to 7 day supply in an airtight, waterproof container.



Water. At least 3 to 7 days of water specifically for each pet.



Medicines and medical records.



Important documents. Pet registration, adoption papers and vaccination documents.



Pet first aid kit.



Collar or harness with ID tag, rabies tag and a leash.



A picture of you and your pet together. To prove ownership if separated.



Toys. Familiar items to help reduce stress for your pets.



Sanitation. Include pet litter box, paper towels, plastic trash bags and household chlorine bleach.



Windbreakers. To keep animals safe from frigid conditions.



Crate. Have a large, sturdy and safe crate or carrier in case you need to evacuate.
